BY-LAW CHANGES

To be voted on at the 2004 September Stated Meeting.

Article III Section 1 (now reads)

"The stated meetings of this lodge shall be held at 7:00 PM on the first Tuesday in each month, except stated meetings will not be held during the months of July & August."

Be it resolved that:

Article III Section I be changed to read - (eliminations in ~~strike through~~)

"The stated meetings of this lodge shall be held at 7:00 PM on the first Tuesday in each month." ~~Except stated meetings will not be held during the months of July & August.~~

Change Article 4 to conform to the rest of the headings and show it as IV.
